

FOAMSPACE PRIVACY STATEMENT

Last Updated: August 3, 2018

This Privacy Statement explains how Foamspace Corp. (“Company”) collects, uses, and discloses information about you through its website, and any other online products and services (collectively, the “Services”) or when you otherwise interact with us.

We may change this Privacy Statement from time to time. If we make changes, we will notify you by revising the date at the top of the Privacy Statement and, in some cases, we may provide you with additional notice (such as adding a statement to our homepage or sending you a notification). We encourage you to review the Privacy Statement whenever you access the Services or otherwise interact with us to stay informed about our information practices and the choices available to you.

Collection of Information

Information You Provide to Us

We collect information when you sign up for our mailing list or connect to our community via Telegram or otherwise provide information directly to us.

Information We Collect from Other Sources

We may obtain information from other sources and combine that with information we collect through our Services. For example, our third-party token sale vendor, Token Foundry, may share with us the information it collects about you in connection with our token sale.

Automatically Collected Information

When you access or use our Services, we automatically collect information about you, including:

- **Log Information:** We collect log information about your use of the Services, including the type of browser you use, access times, pages viewed, your IP address and the page you visited before navigating to our Services.
- **Device Information:** We collect information about the computer or mobile device you use to access our Services, including the hardware model, operating system and version, unique device identifiers, and mobile network information.
- **Information Collected by Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies:** We use various technologies to collect information, including cookies and web beacons. Cookies are small data files stored on your hard drive or in device memory

that help us improve our Services and your experience, see which areas and features of our Services are popular and count visits. Web beacons are electronic images that may be used in our Services or emails and help deliver cookies, count visits and understand usage and campaign effectiveness. For more information about cookies and how to disable them, please see “Your Choices” below.

Use of Information

We use the information we collect to provide, maintain, improve, and develop our website and other possible services. We may also use the information we collect to:

- Comply with U.S. or other regulatory and legal obligations, including in connection with anti-money laundering, know your customer requirements, and applicable sanctions or embargoes;
- Send you technical notices, updates, security alerts and support and administrative messages and to respond to your comments, questions and requests;
- Communicate with you about products, services, offers, and events offered by Company and others, and provide news and information we think will be of interest to you;
- Monitor and analyze trends, usage and activities in connection with our Services; and
- Detect, investigate and prevent fraudulent transactions and other illegal activities and protect the rights and property of Company and others.

Sharing of Information

We may share information about you as follows or as otherwise described in this Privacy Statement:

- With vendors, consultants and other service providers who need access to such information to carry out work on our behalf;
- With third parties for their own services and marketing purposes, unless you opt out of this type of sharing by emailing us at info@foam.space;
- In response to a request for information if we believe disclosure is in accordance with, or required by, any applicable law, regulation or legal process;
- If we believe your actions are inconsistent with our terms of service or policies, or to protect the rights, property and safety of Company or others;

- In connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, financing or acquisition of all or a portion of our business by another company;
- Between and among Company and any future parents, affiliates, subsidiaries and other companies under common control and ownership; and
- With your consent or at your direction.

We may also share aggregated or de-identified information, which cannot reasonably be used to identify you.

Social Sharing Features

The Services may offer social sharing features and other integrated tools (such as the Facebook “Like” button). Your use of such features enables the sharing of information with your friends or the public, depending on the settings you establish with the entity that provides the social sharing feature. Advertising and Analytics Services Provided by Others

We may allow others to provide analytics services and serve advertisements on our behalf across the internet and in applications. These entities may use cookies, web beacons, device identifiers and other technologies to collect information about your use of the Services and other websites and applications, including your IP address, web browser, mobile network information, pages viewed, time spent on pages or in apps, links clicked and conversion information. This information may be used by Company and others to, among other things, analyze and track data, determine the popularity of certain content, deliver advertising and content targeted to your interests on our Services and other websites and better understand your online activity. Security

Company takes reasonable measures to help protect information about you from loss, theft, misuse and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration and destruction.

Data Retention

We store the information we collect about you for as long as is necessary for the purpose(s) for which we originally collected it, or for other legitimate business purposes, including to meet our legal or other regulatory obligations. This may include, among other purposes, storing information in compliance with the U.S.

Department of Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control recordkeeping guidelines of at least five years.

Transfer of Information to the U.S. and Other Countries

Company is based in the United States and we process and store information in the U.S. and other countries. As such, we and our service providers may transfer your information to, or store or access it in, jurisdictions that may not provide equivalent levels of data protection as your home jurisdiction. We will take steps to ensure that your personal data receives an adequate level of protection in the jurisdictions in which we process it.

Residents of the European Economic Area

If you are a resident of the European Economic Area ("EEA"), you have certain rights and protections under the law regarding the processing of your personal data.

Legal Basis for Processing

If you are a resident of the EEA, when we process your personal data we will only do so in the following situations:

- We need to use your personal data to perform our responsibilities under our contract with you (e.g., in connection with providing the services you have requested, or complying with U.S. or other regulatory and legal obligations).
- We have a legitimate interest in processing your personal data. For example, we may process your personal data to send you marketing communications, to communicate with you about changes to our Services, and to provide, secure, and improve our Services.
- You have consented to the processing of your personal data for one or more specific purposes.

Data Subject Requests

If you are a resident of the EEA, you have the right to access personal data we hold about you and to ask that your personal data be corrected, erased, or transferred. You may also have the right to object to, or request that we restrict, certain processing. If you would like to exercise any of these rights, you can email us at info@foam.space.

Questions or Complaints
